Matt Gallagher is the author of four books, including Youngblood, a finalist for the Dayton Literary Peace Prize. His work has appeared in Esquire, ESPN, The New York Times, The Paris Review, and Wired, among other places. A U.S. Army veteran of the Iraq war, his new book, Daybreak, is a novel about the ongoing Russo-Ukrainian conflict. In February 2022, as Russia's renewed invasion of Ukraine began, Gallagher joined fellow combat veterans Adrian Bonenberger and Benjamin Busch in the Ukrainian city of Lviv to voluntarily train a civilian defense force.
